

Covid-19 Recreational, Novice & Dance Procedures

Updated: Dec 2020

Upon Arrival

- Participants are required to be dressed ready for their session, we ask where possible that bags and coats do not come inside.
- No drinking facilities on site, please bring a water bottle with you if required. If your child comes
 without a water bottle and requires a drink we will issue them with a bottle from our café and
 bill your account.
- All personnel entering the facility must wash their hands with soap and water before entry using the outside basin.
- Participants can queue or wait in cars until 5 minutes before class, when they may enter
- Parents / Guardians can wait with participants outside the gym but must be wearing a face covering if doing so.
- Parents / Guardians of school aged children will not be allowed inside the building to view sessions. Access inside to view our onsite leotards or speak with our administrators can be accommodated once your child's class has entered. You will need to wash hands, wear a face covering and have temperature checked before entry.
- Upon entry, a member of staff will guide participants on where to sit and place their shoes and water.

During Sessions

- Participants will be split into groups and lead to a designated warm up area by their coach.
- All participants entering the gymnasium in bare feet, will walk through a sanitizing mat.
- Participants will be encouraged to socially distance, the use of markers on the floor will be used if needed to provide a visual queue for children.
- Each group will get the opportunity to work on all the equipment whilst staying within their group, upon moving equipment all participants will sanitize their hands.
- Staff members will wipe down all high touch areas between groups and a bigger clean down of all areas with anti-viral cleaners, including toilets, between sessions.

Toilets

- Participants are encouraged to go to the toilet before entering the facility.
- Participants requiring the toilet, need to speak to a member of staff so that they can be shown to their allocated toilet.
- Each group's toilet will be thoroughly cleaned between sessions and access to anti-bacterial wipes are available.
- Toilets will not be available for public use.

Departure

- Any Parents/ Guardians arriving for pick up must wear a face covering and are asked to wait in the garden to the side of the building.
- Participants will need to dress themselves and leave through the side door, leaving their boxes to be cleaned by staff members.
- Participants will be dismissed individually by staff once the person collecting them has arrived.
- Please leave the premises as quickly as possible and do not mingle with others in the car park.
