A fire marshal will be on site for the entirety of the competition. All coaches to dynamically assess that all fire exits are kept clear and all fire doors are closed. Any obstructions must be moved immediately. Head Coach to ensure that the fire exits at the end of the building, from the Nursery and the spiral staircase are unlocked before admitting any competitors and guests. 	L	H	Medium

To enable this to happen a barrier must be placed around the floor square to the track stairs ensuring a clear path that is to be used by the spectators. Due to gymnastics taking place on the floor square it is important the spectators are informed not to leave their seats while a floor routine / floor warm up is taking place. This will be communicated in the house keeping speech. 	M	M	Medium
Overcrowding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Employees/Staff Public Customers Pupils/Students 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A strict policy of a maximum of 25 gymnasts and 50-60 spectator must be adhered to for each round. This is able to be maintained to pre organised groupings and pre sold tickets. A strict order of play must be followed so that the round previous has left the building before inviting in the next group of spectators. Prior good communication with spectators is necessary as well as door signs on the day stipulating times of entry. 	H	L	Medium
