Falling from height	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Young Persons • Volunteer Workers • Visitors • Public • Employees/Staff 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff to ensure all adults supervise their children during class activities. • Ensure staff are adequately trained in pre-school gymnastics or are being mentored by such. • Equipment is regularly checked for deterioration and any faults reported to the Centre Manager and/or the Head coach and the admin team and the item is withdrawn. • Support should be sought from another staff member before removing any equipment from any storage area above head height. • Coaches to be aware of the risks of falling relative to the height of the gymnast and children are supported either by a parent or coach when dismounting equipment. • Staff to ensure that parents are comfortable when supporting their children dismounting from equipment. Slips/trips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employees/Staff • Customers • Young Persons • Temporary Workers • Volunteer Workers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any spillages are cleaned up and correct wet floor signage used • Equipment is stored away when not in use. • Coaches to complete a walk through of the training area prior to any class starts to assess any hazard and remove and obstruction. • Coaches to ensure all adults supervise their children during the class session. • Ensure staff are suitably pre-school trained or are being mentored by such. 	M	L	Low
Double Mini Trampoline use	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Public • Young Persons • Customers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only 1 child at any time should be allowed to use the DMT. The use by more than one may lead to the "double bounce" phenomena which is likely to result in injury. • No adults should use the DMT at any time. Such use is likely to accelerate the deterioration of the spring mechanism which could cause product malfunction. 	M	M	Medium
